The Camp

Onondaga Camp is a summer overnight camp for children ages 6-16 near Minden, Ontario. We facilitate over 1,500 campers each summer. We hire staff on the basis of the soundness and maturity of their judgment, their commitment to being strong role models, and most importantly their ability to establish positive and caring relationships with their campers.

The Position

Onondaga is looking for an Assistant Head of High Ropes for the summer of 2019 to run our High Ropes program under the supervision of our Head of High Ropes.

Onondaga's ropes program consists of a Challenge Course, Triple Flying Fox, Climbing Wall, and Giant Swing. The Assistant Head of Ropes role will manage the ropes course and staff of approximately 15 members with the Head of Ropes. Onondaga's ropes program has over 55 campers in its program as well as 12 staff working at a given time. Duties as the Assistant Head of High Ropes include management and inventory of all equipment, periodical element inspections, proper logging of all ropes elements, and staff scheduling and management. The ideal candidate enjoys working in an outdoor environment and can envision themselves spending the majority of the day at a ropes course in a children's camp environment.

Necessary Qualifications/Competencies

- ➤ Challenges Unlimited, Elevation Designs, or Adventure Works Level 1 or 2 Certification (or willingness to obtain).
- Experience with high ropes courses ideally in a children's camp environment is ideal.

- > Previous experience leading and managing a small team is considered an asset.
- Lifesaving Society Bronze Cross or National Lifeguard is considered an asset.
