2020 CANOE TRIP INFORMATION

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Canoe trips are a valuable part of the Onondaga Camp experience and we encourage all campers who are attending two and four week sessions to participate. Many campers look forward to the opportunity to get to see some of Ontario's great outdoors while being in the company of their friends as well as amazing staff. We are fortunate to run our canoe trips in the Leslie Frost Centre and Algonquin Park.

All of our canoe trips are accompanied by one of our experienced and trained canoe trip leaders who will be assisted by one of our counsellings staff. Most canoe trips have up to seven campers.

Bantam, Inter, Senior and Super Senior campers (aged 11 to 15 in 2020) must sign up for their canoe trip before they come to camp. This allows us to make the necessary Provincial Park bookings as popular trip routes are becoming harder to secure each year.

Please note that all campers born in 2010, enrolled in a two week or four week session, will have the opportunity to participate in an overnight trip. Sign up is not required for Jinci campers. Canoe trips are not offered in our one week session (C session).

Canoe trip sign up is done at the time of registration. Changes can be made, through the camp office, until June 1, 2020. Please note that, regrettably, changes and sign up are not possible after this date.

Please note that Onondaga Camp reserves the right to cancel canoe trips due to low enrollment. This situation happens infrequently and parents will be notified right away if a trip is being cancelled.

Canoe Trip Lengths

Bantam (born in 2008 & 2009): 3 Day Trip

Inter (born in 2007): 4 Day Trip

Senior (born in 2006): 4 Day Trip or 7 Day Trip (4 week campers only)

Super Senior (born in 2004 or 2005): 4 Day Trip or 7 Day Trip (4 week campers only)
