Onondaga Camp is committed to ensuring the health and well-being of campers & staff as our first priority. As such, it is important that all campers & staff confirm the status of their vaccinations.

Summer 2022 COVID-19 Vaccination Policy

Onondaga Camp requires all participants in our programs, including campers, LITs and Staff, who are eligible to be fully vaccinated, to be fully vaccinated with a Health Canada approved Covid-19 vaccine at least two weeks prior to their arrival at camp and will be required to demonstrate proof thereof.

Onondaga Camp requires that all full-time staff be fully vaccinated and demonstrate proof thereof. All on-site visitors must demonstrate proof of full vaccination.

Application for exemption by person who cannot be fully vaccinated will be considered by Onondaga Camp and its medical advisors. Persons requesting an exemption will be required to provide appropriate documentation to support their request.

For the purpose of this policy, "fully vaccinated" means having received the completed series shots, as approved by Health Canada. Onondaga Camp strongly recommends a 3rd dose for all those who are eligible.

Information collected by Onondaga Camp pursuant to this policy will be held in strict confidence and used only for the specific purposes described in this policy and will be held in accordance with Onondaga Camp's privacy policy and applicable privacy laws.
