### **The Camp**

Onondaga Camp is a summer overnight camp for children ages 6-16 near Minden, Ontario. We facilitate over 1,500 campers each summer. We hire staff on the basis of the soundness and maturity of their judgment, their commitment to being strong role models, and most importantly their ability to establish positive and caring relationships with their campers.

### **The Position**

The Head of Canoe Programs is responsible for managing our entire canoeing program. This includes 5 activity periods per day, instructing campers of all skill level (6-15 years old), from lake tours in large boats to solo paddling skills.

The head of canoeing also works each morning before breakfast with groups of 16 year olds working on their ORCKA Level 4 solo paddling skills.

- Management & Inventory of 20 canoes, paddles, other equipment.
- Managing a group of staff and leadership program participants, including feedback & work delegation
- Administrative organization of levels for all campers

- Extensive paddling experience & variety of skills
- Experience teaching/leading youth
- Staff management & administrative organizational skills
