Routine Immunization Policy

The Ontario Ministry of Health recommends the following Publicly Funded Immunization schedule:

If there is an outbreak of a disease targeted by Ontario's routine vaccination program (eg. measles) the following individuals will be sent home at their own expense:

Any camper or staff member who:

- a) is unvaccinated;
- b) has followed an atypical vaccination schedule;
- c) has not completed a Health History form or;
- d) has not provided an immunization record.

Removal from camp will be for an isolation period determined by Public Health Ontario. No refunds will be issued for camp fees for time missed at camp. Staff salary will be prorated to the date of departure. All transportation costs incurred will be the responsibility of the camper parent/guardian or staff member.

Summer COVID-19 Vaccination Policy

Onondaga Camp strongly recommends that all participants in our programs, including campers, LITs and Staff be vaccinated against Covid-19 including any booster doses as recommended by the Ontario Ministry of Health.
